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| <p>Return to Campus</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ School as scheduled for Preschool - Kindergarten: First day of classes on September 1, 2020 with half-day classes for first two weeks ▪ Distance Learning with outdoor meet-ups once per week for 1st-12 grade students ▪ Classes: Stable groups of students and teacher/s in a room/outdoors ▪ Full school days, Monday-Friday, for Preschool - 12th grade ▪ Small groups in classrooms ▪ Staggered Arrival and Dismissal procedures ▪ Before Care will be on hold until further notice ▪ Aftercare will be open until 5:30 PM for students who have signed up no later than August 3, 2020 ▪ No drop-in Aftercare until further notice ▪ Specialist classes: World Language, Music, Art, & Yoga held online ▪ Physical Education will be outdoor education at this time ▪ Events, community meetings, and other large gatherings are on hold or modified until further notice ▪ Distance learning option for PS - K programs ▪ Once additional grades join in-person classes, students may join live classroom lessons using Logitech Meetups if parents choose to keep their child home | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Temperature checks completed and health forms filled out each day upon arrival ▪ Ill students and teachers will remain home ▪ Face masks must be worn by students older than 2 years old and by adults, unless there is a health concern (and those too young to manage) ▪ Daily hand hygiene practice ▪ Parents and visitors will not enter the school building ▪ Parents will notify the school of any COVID-19 symptoms and keep their child at home until evaluated by a doctor ▪ Students or staff who are exposed to and individual testing positive for COVID-19 will stay home for 14 days or have a negative test result ▪ Staff and family members traveling to areas with a COVID-19 rate higher than 5% will quarantine at home for 14 days upon return ▪ If a staff member or student tests positive for COVID-19, the school will move to distance learning for two weeks. ▪ One student in a bathroom at a time. ▪ Elevator will remain closed to students. One adult in the elevator at a time. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Daily cleaning including disinfecting of all surface areas will happen at the end of each school day ▪ Continued frequent cleaning of high touch surfaces during the school day ▪ Air filters installed in each room used ▪ Playground equipment is cleaned after each group use |
